



2026 Kinney Drugs Citizen Scholarship for Student Athletes

Description of Award

This year, the Vermont Lake Monsters and Kinney Drugs will host a scholarship competition for graduating high school senior student athletes. This year, two (2) scholarships of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) will be awarded; One student athlete from a boys team and one student athlete from a girls team.

Who is Eligible?

Students eligible for this competition must be graduating seniors from an accredited public or private high school within the State of Vermont. You must also be a resident of Vermont. Scholarship awards must be applied towards any 2–4-year college or university, vocational or technical education institution or program.

How is the recipient selected?

Awards are judged on several criteria including examples of leadership, community service, and extracurricular activities. The student must include two letters of recommendation and a letter of acceptance from the institution they plan on attending. Applications must be completed and returned to the Vermont Lake Monsters by **June 30, 2026**. The Vermont Lake Monsters and Kinney Drugs will review the applications and choose one male and one female winner. The winners will be announced **August 3, 2026** at the Lake Monsters game.

1. All applicants must meet the above criteria.
2. Please fill out the enclosed application form completely (retyped answers are preferred). Answer questions 8-13 on a separate piece of paper. Applications that are not completely filled out are subject to disqualification.
3. Attach a copy of the letter of acceptance from the institution you plan on attending.
4. Enclose two letters of recommendation complete with name, address and phone numbers.
